<b>Program</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Afternoon Chats</b>	Members (50 and Over) who want to meditate or sit quietly and end the hour with a cup of tea and opportunity to chat.
<b>Betsy's Cupboard</b>	Food pantry: fill your shopping bags with 25 pounds of food items of your choice. Eligible within a thirty day period by appointment. <i>Appointments are made in advance and fill up quickly! In order to ensure availability, please schedule your appointment with the Resource Desk.</i>
<b>Bridget's Boutique</b>	Clothing boutique with both women's and children's items. Eligible to pick ten items every thirty days. By appointment only. Make appointments at the Resource Desk.
<b>CICP Mobile Van</b>	Enrollment Van from Denver Health. Assists with Medicaid and CICP enrollment services. 2nd Thurs of the month.
<b>Community Insurance Options</b>	Help to find insurance plans that fit member's needs.
<b>Computer Lab</b>	Open lab for email, resume writing, internet use, games, etc. The lab is always staffed with a volunteer to assist you. You can print up to 5 pages per day. There is no downloading in the lab. If others are waiting, there is a 30 minute time limit.
<b>Dental Van</b>	Dental services for members and their children. Monthly - 3rd and 4th Friday from 9-3. Sign up at time of service. Insurance accepted: Colorado Medicaid.
<b>Denver Health Navigator</b>	Help to schedule cancer screenings, including mammograms and Pap tests, as well as find a primary care doctor. In addition can connect to Medicaid enrollment specialist.
<b>Denver Human Services</b>	Staff from DHS is here every day of the week at 9am to assist with housing and other questions. The sign up is located in the Wellness area, first come first serve basis.
<b>Denver School of Nursing</b>	See a nursing student for a wellness check-up or other non-emergency health issues.
<b>Fiber Arts</b>	Join us to crochet/knit in a group setting. We can provide instruction, inspiration, community, yarn, and needles. All skill levels are welcome and encouraged.
<b>HSE</b>	Work to complete your GED. Intakes are usually the 4 <sup>th</sup> Friday of the month. Basic GED Skills Classes are on Monday and Wednesday.
<b>Haircuts</b>	Licensed hairdressers come on the 2 <sup>nd</sup> Mondays of every month in the morning. Sign up that same day until list is full—12 spots only.
<b>Job Application/Search</b>	Dedicated time in the computer lab to search and apply for jobs. Monday and Wednesday afternoons. Working to create, edit, or update resumes and cover letters
<b>Lawyers</b>	Lawyers from the community are here to help with basic single session legal advice on the 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> Thursday of every month.
<b>Mail</b>	Use The Gathering Place as your mail address. You must check your mail once a week, and can only check it once per day.
<b>Mammogram Van</b>	Women's Mobile Clinic from Denver Health. Provides quarterly services on 2nd Thursday of the month for Feb, April, July, Oct.
<b>MHAC Counseling</b>	We have a variety of mental health counselors who are here to listen, support, and counsel. Some provide individual opportunities and some provide support groups.
<b>Streets Hope</b>	Drop-in/Crisis Mental Health Counseling and Case Management Services and Weekly support Group.
<b>Stout Street Mobile Clinic Van</b>	The Health Outreach Providers from Stout Street Clinic see adult women to treat basic medical needs.
<b>Talking Circle</b>	Traditional Native American support group that welcomes all Native American clients for a multi-tribe inclusive talking circle.
<b>The Card Project</b>	Express yourself, develop and promote your work as an artist of any level in a safe environment by making cards of your own design. Materials provided. Cards are sold throughout the community with artist making 75% of the sale price. New artists always welcomed.
<b>The Writers Group</b>	A guided opportunity to talk and write about differed topics in a relaxed atmosphere. You can come to journal, work on legal documents/paperwork, creative writing, etc.
<b>The Music Group</b>	Join us to create music in an open setting. All skill levels are welcomed and encouraged.
