
How You Can Help **Donate**

DONATE ESSENTIAL ITEMS

Our members need **new and unopened** baby items and personal supplies, as well as **non-perishable**, **unexpired** food—see suggestions below. For more information, please contact **Ali Medina** at (303) 996-9046 or alison@tgpdenver.org.

New Baby Items

Baby powder, lotion, shampoo, and bath wash; baby wipes; children's vitamins; Pedialyte; sippy-cups; unexpired baby food; unopened packages of diapers (sizes 4, 5, 6 and pull-ups); toddler socks and underwear.

Personal Supplies

Combs/brushes; denture care items such as Polygrip and Efferdent; toothbrushes, toothpaste and floss; deodorant, lip balm; socks; underwear; shampoo and conditioner; tampons/pads; lotion; razors; Black hair products; toilet paper; reusable shopping bags.

Non-Perishable, Unexpired, Healthy Food Items

In an effort to support the health of those we serve, we prefer organic, low-sodium, low-sugar, and healthy fat food item donations, whenever possible.

Examples: fresh fruits and vegetables; fruit and/or vegetable juice; beans (dry or canned); brown rice; whole grain cereal, oatmeal, pasta; canned fruits, vegetables, soups; canned tuna, chicken or salmon; whole grain bread; whole grain bread, biscuit, and pancake mixes; peanut butter and jelly; snack items (e.g. tuna and cracker packs, popped or microwave popcorn, nuts); vegetable oil; coffee, tea, cider, or cocoa packets; granola/cereal bars; and, vegetarian products.

Please note, the only clothing we are able to accept onsite are new socks and underwear and clean items on hangers. Because of health, safety, and storage issues, we ask that you donate other clothing and household items to one of our partners, listed below.
